PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

BACHELOR'S DEGREE GRADUATES (POST-BACS)*

- Recent graduates' (less than 24 months) from a bachelor's degree in Natural Sciences, Social Sciences and Engineering (Biomedical and Chemical).
- Individuals already accepted in professional and/or graduate degree programs are not eligible.
- Only individuals from academic institutions in Puerto Rico are eligible.

WHAT CAN REPAIR OFFER YOU?

- 57-week full-time internship in Puerto Rico hosted by the University of Puerto Rico Comprehensive Cancer Center (UPRCCC).
- Hands-on research experience within the scope of the cancer control continuum, focused on the links between microbes, infections, and cancer at the UPRCCC or other affiliated institutions.
- Participants are matched to a mentor based on their research interests.
- Seminars & workshops to strengthen professional and research skills.
- Participants receive a financial stipend.
